

The Fulton Chain of Lakes Association is most appreciative to the Town of Webb Fund of the Community Foundation of Herkimer and Oneida Counties, INC. for their generous check to assist with our aquatic plant survey. The FCLA began five years ago to eradicate Eurasian Milfoil from Fifth Lake. Volunteers began a labor intensive program to hand pick each plant. Milfoil was later found in both Sixth and Seventh Lake and it soon became obvious that the program needed expansion. With the assistance of the Town of Webb and the Town of Inlet grants were obtained and needed funding was acquired. Literally tons of Eurasian Milfoil has been removed from Fifth, Sixth and Seventh Lake. Three to four divers are hired each summer to remove plants and the beds have become smaller and smaller. This year the FCLA hired an outside agency to do a surface mapping of the entire Fulton Chain. The mapping will determine the type of aquatic plants growing and their location. We thank the Town of Webb Fund for their help in our ongoing endeavor to eradicate Eurasian Milfoil from the Fulton Chain.
